Steam Weed Control

Steam weed control is a chemical free alternative to traditional weed control using herbicides. The method involves applying superheated saturated steam to the weed infestation and is an ideal alternative to traditional weed control along hardstand areas such as footpaths, kerbs, and median islands. It is also suited to selected landscaped and streetscaped areas as well as around schools, offices and buildings.

This method of weed control uses water only, it is safe for use in public areas, has no lasting effects on the environment and can be applied in all weather conditions. The treatment works by rupturing the cell wall in the weed which causes the weed to wilt and die.

Natural Area *EnviroSteam* Units

The Natural Area *EnviroSteam* weed control unit was developed collaboratively by Natural Area and manufacturer Quik Spray, and is available in both single hose reel and dual hose reel variants as part of Natural Area's weed control fleet, which is the largest in WA. Natural Area's *EnviroSteam* units are ready for operation throughout the Perth Metropolitan Region and South West by our team of highly trained and licenced weed control professionals.

Safety by design was paramount in the development of the system with the boiler being fully shrouded and able to produce hotter steam than other units currently on the market; this reduces application time and water use, and provides a cost-effective non-chemical solution for our clients.
